

OPEN AND JUNIOR ALL-PENNSYLVANIA CONTEST RULES

ELIGIBILITY RULES

1. Registered Guernseys of which the ownership is at least 50% by a PA Guernsey Breeder. Animals must be housed in PA.
2. The animal must have been shown in at least one PA Coutny or a State Fair, or the PA all-Americna Dairy Show or a National Guernsey Show.
3. Entries must be received at the Pennsylvveania Guernsey Breeders' Association office on or before December 1 of that year and include the following:
 - a) Current show season placings
 - b) A statement of ownership

CLASSES

1. Junior Heifer Calf - Born from March 1, 2003 through May 30, 2003
2. Intermediate Heifer Calf - Born from December 1, 2002 through February 28, 2003
3. Senior Heifer Calf - Born September 1, 2002 through November 31, 2002
4. Summer Yearling - Born June 1, 2002 through August 31, 2002
5. Junior Yearling - Born March 1, 2002 through May 30, 2002
6. Intermediate Yearling - Born December 1, 2001 through February 28, 2002
7. Senior Yearling - Born September 1, 2001 through November 31, 2001
8. Junior Two-Year-Old Cow - Born March 1, 2001 through August 31, 2001
9. Senior Two-Year-Old Cow - Born September 1, 2000 through February 28, 2001
10. Junior Three-Year-Old Cow - Born March 1, 2000 through August 31, 2000
11. Senior Three-Year-Old Cow - Born September 1, 1999 through February 28, 2000
12. Four-Year-Old Cow - Born September 1, 1998 through August 31, 1999
13. Five-Year-Old Cow - Born September 1, 1997 through August 31, 1998
14. Six Year Old Cow and Over - Born prior to September 1, 1997
15. Best Bred and Owned with a photocopy of registration papers.

A cow shown dry will be entered in her appropriate age class and receive half of the pint value while she is shown dry.

POINT SCALE: Below is the point system to be used in the selection of the All-Pennsylvania winners in *OPEN OR JUNIOR CLASSES*. *POINTS FOR OPEN AND JUNIOR PLACING MUST BE ENTERED SEPARATELY ON SEPARATE FORMS*

National Shows	Top of Class = 20 Points <i>(Points for 20 Placings)</i>
Pennsylvania and National Futurity	Top of Class = 10 Points <i>(Points for 10 Places)</i>
State Shows - 70 Head or More	Top of Class = 10 Points <i>(Points for 10 Places)</i>
State Shows - Under 70 Head - Or Local Shows	Top of Class = 3 Points <i>(Points for 3 Places)</i>

National Shows - Grand or Junior Champion = 10 Points

National Shows - Reserve Grand or Reserve Junior Champion = 5 Points

State Shows (over 70 head shown) - Grand or Junior Champion = 4 Points

State Shows (over 70 head shown) - Reserve Grand or Reserve Junior Champion = 2 Points

State Shows (under 70 head shown) or Local Shows - Grand or Junior Champion = 2 Points

State Shows (under 70 head shown) or Local Shows - Reserve Grand or Reserve Junior Champion = 1 Point
